Lifeline Program Offers Telephone Discounts to Eligible Vermonters

Many individuals or low-income families qualify for assistance with phone charges, but don't realize that this help is available to them.

If you're experiencing financial difficulties, or have a friend or family member in this situation, Waitsfield and Champlain Valley Telecom encourages you to look into the Lifeline Program. Lifeline provides qualified customers with a monthly discount on charges for their primary home phone line. Here in Vermont, you can save up to \$9.25 per month

Who is eligible for the Lifeline Telephone Credit?

Two groups of Vermont residents with telephone service are eligible for the credit. You are eligible if you reside in Vermont, have phone service, and

- You will be 65 or older by June 15, 2015 and your household income is less than \$27,528;
- You are under 65 and your household income is less than \$23,596;

Persons who receive 3Squares VT, Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8), Fuel Assistance, Medicaid, National School Lunch Program's Free Lunch Program, Reach Up, or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) may also be eligible to apply year-round for Lifeline through the Economic Services Division.

When and how do you apply?

You must apply for the Lifeline Credit each year. All eligible telephone subscribers should mail the completed application on or before June 15, 2015 to: The Lifeline Program 103 S. Main Street Waterbury, VT 05671

Is Your Internet Plan Sized to Support Multiple Users and Multiple Devices?

Does your family do a lot of gaming and streaming movies through Netflix? Are there multiple devices in your household including laptops, tablets, and smartphones? Have you noticed your Internet speeds seem to be going down as your usage goes up? Many Waitsfield and Champlain Valley Telecom customers are saturating their bandwidth because multiple devices in their homes are connected wirelessly to the Internet. This makes it seem as though their Internet service is running slow when it's actually being maxed out.

Households with several family members accessing the Internet simultaneously will be happiest with one of our higher-level plans that provide greater bandwidth and faster speeds:

- 12-20 Mbps \$49.95/month*
- 50 Mbps \$59.95/month*
- 100 Mbps \$99.95/month*

What exactly is bandwidth? The term refers to how much data you can send through a network or modem connection. Bandwidth is usually measured in bits per second, such as 10 Mbps (10 million bits per second). You can think of bandwidth



as a highway with cars traveling on it; the highway is the network connection and the cars are the data. The wider the highway, the more cars can travel on it at one time and the faster they get to their destinations. The same principle applies to data — the more bandwidth, the more information that can be transferred within a given amount of time.

As you use more web-connected devices, and use them for more data-intensive applications, it's important to make sure your bandwidth increases as well.
