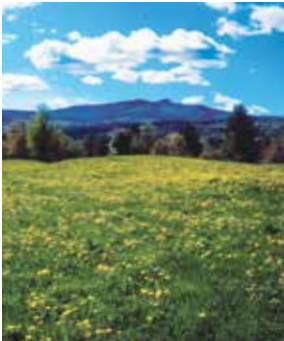

CASE STUDY: HYDE AWAY INN & RESTAURANT

Business-Class Wi-Fi is now one of many reasons guests are happy at the Hyde Away Inn & Restaurant in Fayston, Vermont.

The Challenge

In the past, the Hyde Away was suffering from inconsistent Wi-Fi signals and started to get complaints about it from some customers on social media. People loved the lodging experience, food, and location, but the Wi-Fi was less than stellar.

The Solution

WCVT Sales Manager Kris Merchant recommended a switch to Business-Class Wi-Fi, a Wi-Fi platform powered by Ruckus Wireless products. WCVT created a business network for the Hyde Away's point-of-sale system and a guest network with an active portal. Guests can login with an email address and other information and then gain access to the guest Wi-Fi network. This setup enables the Hyde Away to use guest login information for marketing programs in the future if they so desire.

Clear Water Filtration

On a mission to provide clean, safe water in Vermont and beyond

An avid pilot, Jim Parker dreamed of someday having a hanger that could double as his office space. This dream came true in 1970, but after drilling the well for his Vermont hanger, Parker discovered water loaded with iron. His search for an effective filter solution eventually led to the creation of Clear Water Filtration in 1980.

A Small but Mighty Team

The business quickly took flight. By 1985, Clear Water Filtration had grown to include five employees and became an authorized independent Kinetico dealer. It expanded into the commercial market in 1990. Today, the business serves residential and commercial customers in Central and Northern Vermont, Eastern New York, and Western New Hampshire with products including:

- Drinking water systems
- Water softening systems
- Water filtration systems
- Disinfection systems

Steve Parker and his sister Jen Fleckenstein bought Clear Water Filtration from their father in 2015 and continue its mission of providing clean, safe water.

Fleckenstein notes, “We now have 12 employees who work in our Waitsfield office. In addition, we employ technicians who operate out of their homes, which are strategically located throughout Vermont. This enables Clear Water Filtration to quickly respond to customer needs in our three-state service area. As I like to say, we have a small but mighty team.”

Clearly Better Phone and Internet from WCVT

This team needed an efficient and reliable phone system, which it didn’t have until recently. Fleckenstein explains, “We previously leased a phone system through Avaya, and that phone system was problematic. It went down a lot, didn’t have all the bells and whistles we needed, and required us to go into the programming of the phone and enter a series of codes to make even simple changes. We needed to find something better.”

Clear Water Filtration switched to a Hosted IP phone system from WCVT, and Fleckenstein is pleased with the difference. “It was like night and day when we made the switch. Hosted IP is so much easier to use and more reliable than what we had before. We can go into the web portal and quickly make phone changes. Another Hosted IP feature I appreciate is Voice Mail to Email. It’s a convenient way to get messages, especially when I’m traveling,” she says.

Upgrading to WCVT’s fiber internet service also made a positive impact on Clear Water Filtration’s operations. Fleckenstein notes, “Our internet speeds are significantly faster now that we’re connected to the WCVT fiber network. We use cloud-based systems, so faster download and upload speeds are important for us.”

My father, Jim Parker, was an aerobatics pilot for 40 years and produced air shows in Vermont to raise money for various charities. Gregg volunteered at those events and was a generous donor and supporter. WCVT employees have also helped us set up at the air shows, which is no small task. WCVT has always been there for our family, and now they’re helping my brother and I carry on the legacy of Clear Water Filtration.”

7 Common Types of Cyberattacks

Hackers use a variety of techniques to try and steal and exploit sensitive data—such as credit card information and passwords—and these techniques continue to evolve. As a business owner or manager, you need to be aware of the most frequently used types of cyberattacks.

1. APT: Advanced persistent threats, or APTs, are long-term targeted attacks that break into a network in multiple phases to avoid detection.

2. DDoS: An acronym for distributed denial of service, DDoS attacks occur when a server is intentionally overloaded with requests to attempt to shut down the target business's website or network system.

3. Inside attack: This refers to a situation where a person with administrative privileges, usually from within the business, purposely misuses his or her credentials to gain access to confidential company information. Former employees, in particular, present a threat if they left on bad terms.

4. Malware: This term is short for malicious software and covers a range of programs introduced into a computer with the goal of causing damage or gaining unauthorized access.

5. Password attacks: There are three main types of password attacks: a brute-force attack, which involves guessing at passwords until the hacker gets in; a dictionary attack, which uses a program to try different combinations of dictionary words; and keylogging, which tracks all of a user's keystrokes, including login IDs and passwords.

6. Phishing: Perhaps the most commonly deployed form of cybertheft, phishing involves collecting sensitive information like login credentials and credit card information through a

legitimate-looking (but ultimately fraudulent) website, often sent to unsuspecting individuals in an email.

7. Ransomware: This type of malware will either lock you out of your computer and demand money in return for access or threaten to publish private information if you don't pay a specified amount in ransom. Ransomware is one of today's fastest growing types of cyberattacks.

WHY DO HACKERS TARGET SMALL BUSINESSES?

Are you surprised by the question posed in this article's headline? Are you one of the many small businesses under the mistaken impression that hackers are only interested in stealing data from big corporations like retail chains? Do you think you don't really have data worth stealing?

Actually, small businesses fall into a "sweet spot" for hackers—they have more digital assets to target than an individual consumer but less security in place than an enterprise business. Small businesses tend to be less consciously aware of their risk for cyberattacks and therefore don't allocate enough time and money for cybersecurity measures.

Statistics point to the fact that small businesses need to pay attention to cybersecurity. According to UPS Capital, nearly two-thirds of data breach victims are small to mid-size businesses, and about 60 percent of smaller businesses are out of business within six months of suffering a cyberattack.¹
