VOICE MAIL FEATURES

Voice Mail Message Notification

Simply lift your receiver and you will be alerted to new Voice Mail messages with a distinctive, stutter dial tone. Also, if you have a compatible telephone the Message Waiting indicator light will illuminate indicating that you have a message.

Fast Login

With Fast Login enabled, a PIN is not required when logging in from the telephone line on which your Voice Mail is programmed. You can enable or disable the feature. Fast Login is disabled by default.

Email Notification

Forward your Voice Mail messages to your email address. Then listen, save, or delete messages.

Live Call Screening

When a Voice Mail is being recorded, you can pick up the phone and hear the message without the caller knowing you are listening in. If you choose, you can interrupt the message and connect live with the caller.

USING THE VOICE MAIL SYSTEM

The Voice Mail system is menu driven. Simply listen to the voice prompts and press the appropriate key(s) on your phone to select the option you would like.

ACCESSING YOUR VOICE MAIL

The first time you access your Voice Mail box, you will be asked to set up your mailbox and record your name and a greeting.

OUICK TIP

To bypass message

introduction, press #.

From the Telephone Number Subscribed to the Service:

- Dial *99.
- Enter your PIN followed by the # key.
- If you have new messages, the messages will be identified.
- After hearing any new messages, you will be presented with the Main Voice Mail Menu.

From a Different Telephone Number:

- Dial the appropriate Voice Mail access number (see back side for local Voice Mail access numbers).
- Enter your 10-digit telephone number followed by the # sign.
- Enter your PIN followed by the # key.
- If you have new messages, the messages will be identified.
- After hearing any new messages, you will be presented with the Main Voice Mail Menu.

RECORDING YOUR GREETING

- Access your Voice Mail box.
- From the Main Menu, press 3.
- To set up a personal greeting, press 1.
- To set up a system-generated greeting or to change the recording of your name, press 3.

- To change the greeting that callers hear when your telephone is busy, press 5.
- If you don't record a personal greeting, a generic greeting will be played.

CHANGING YOUR VOICE MAIL PIN

- Access your Voice Mail box.
- From the Main Menu, press 4 to change your settings.
- Press 3 for security options.
- Press 1 to change your PIN.

ACCESSING YOUR VOICE MAIL VIA THE INTERNET

Accessing your Voice Mail service online allows you to manage your settings, listen to your Voice Mail messages, and set up Email Notification.

- Visit www.voicemail.wcvt.com.
- Enter 10-digit telephone number and password. (The password is what you use to access your voicemail through your Manage My Voicemail portal online.)

SETTING UP EMAIL NOTIFICATION

Enabling Email Notification will forward your Voice Mail messages to your email address. You can then listen to the messages, save or delete them. This feature can be enabled or disabled at anytime by accessing your account online.

- Access your Voice Mail online.
- Click on Settings tab.
- Click on Messages tab.
- Select "Forward Message as emails" check box.
- Click on Add an Email Address.
- Add email address. (You can can add up to 5 emails).
- Click on the More options dropdown box in the upper right hand corner. Select Help for instructions on box options.
- Click Apply to save changes.
