

Barnard & Gervais, LLC

Two businesses merged to form this full-service environmental consulting firm

Jason Barnard and Michael Gervais established Barnard & Gervais, LLC in January 2016 through the merger of their respective businesses: Jason Barnard Consulting, LLC and Northern Land Surveying, LLC. Barnard brought more than 20 years of experience in wastewater system design, permitting, and environmental consulting to the venture, and Gervais has worked in the land surveying industry for 15+ years specializing in boundary surveying and subdivisions.

Large and Small, Business and Residential

Barnard & Gervais operates out of offices in Hinesburg and Enosburg, offering a menu of service that includes land surveying, water and wastewater system design, state and local permitting, and environmental consulting. These services are provided to architecture firms, contractors, homeowners, land owners, and the Vermont Electric Cooperative.

Jason Barnard, Owner and Managing Partner, said, "Barnard & Gervais works on a variety of small business and residential development projects in and around Addison, Chittenden, Franklin, and Grand Isle counties. For example, in the case of an eight-unit townhouse complex on Richmond Road in Hinesburg, we took it from conceptual design to full design to permitting. We've also done 300-acre surveys for large land owners, boundary surveys of residential properties, and waste water design for single family

homes. We recently completed a survey of a section of the Long Trail State Forest in Waterville and Johnson counties."

To what does Barnard attribute the firm's success? He replied, "I think it's due to our emphasis on building strong client relationships and providing high quality services. We work closely with our clients as well as town officials to keep projects moving and completed in a timely manner."

Convenient Connections With Hosted IP

The Hinesburg and Enosburg offices, staffed by a total of nine people, are connected by a Hosted IP phone system from WCVT.

"Hosted IP is light years ahead of the phone system we had before, which wasn't really a system at all. It consisted of phones from a big box store hooked to landline service. Put simply, the Hosted

IP phone system has made our lives easier, both with interoffice communications and calls between offices. Everyone is set up with a direct line. We also enjoy having the voice mail to email feature, which helps us stay in contact with callers and not lose track of messages. Call management is more streamlined with Hosted IP and gives us lots of flexibility. We have it set up so if our Enosburg office is not staffed on a particular day, after two rings, the calls automatically go to our Hinesburg office," noted Barnard.

Top-Notch Service

In addition to Hosted IP, WCVT provides the Hinesburg office of Barnard & Gervais with fiber internet service, which Barnard described as significantly faster than the non-fiber internet connection at their Enosburg office outside of the WCVT service area.

Maintaining a high level of service is a priority for Barnard & Gervais, and Barnard appreciates a similar dedication from WCVT. He said, "The customer service we get from WCVT is excellent, and their technicians and support staff are all top notch—responsive and professional. If we experience a problem, WCVT will be right here to take care of it. When we bought our building in Hinesburg, they consulted with us and made sure our communications services were set up and working great from day one. When you're getting buried in emails each day, it may seem like the impossible dream to keep up with all the filing, deleting, forwarding, and responding. You know you should reply to that customer's request or that supplier's question, but you can't seem to find the time.

A good place to start is by studying what's typically found in your inbox. If there are hundreds (or thousands) of emails in your inbox right now, you could have a systems issue that needs to be addressed. Consider the following strategies:

- Take a closer look at your spam filter. Does it need to be upgraded or the settings changed?
- Are there newsletters you receive regularly that are no longer of value to you? Unsubscribe to them.
- Are you being copied in on communications unnecessarily? Be clear with colleagues about which projects require emails to be sent to you and which do not.
- · Do you lack an effective system for processing emails or fail to designate adequate time for email management?

Your approach to dealing with each email is also vitally important. Efficiency experts generally recommend you check emails periodically, but not constantly, during the workday. Scan them quickly to determine which are most urgent/important, then read them in order of priority. The goal is to read each email once and act on it—either by replying, filing, or deleting. If you can't immediately act on a particular email, set up a to-do task and schedule a time that you are going to complete this task.

The bottom line is this: Don't let email reduce your productivity. Instead, manage it more carefully so that you have the time to effectively communicate with those people most critical to the success of your business.
