

ABC is bringing back the classic TV game show *Supermarket Sweep*, hosted and executive produced by Emmy® Award-nominated comedienne and actress Leslie Jones. B-Positive revolves around Drew, a therapist and newly divorced dad who is faced with finding a kidney donor when he runs into Gina, a rough-around-the-edges woman from his past who volunteers her own kidney. Together, they form an unlikely and life-affirming friendship as they begin a journey that will forever impact both of their lives. *B-Positive* will air on Thursdays at 8:30 p.m. (Channel 3).

Originally conceived as a 30 Rock spin-off, the new series revolves around a wealthy businessman (*The Good Place* star Ted Danson) who runs for mayor of Los Angeles for all the wrong reasons. Once he wins, he has to figure out what he stands for, gain the respect of his staff, and connect with his teenage daughter—all while humanely controlling the coyote population. *Mr. Mayor* will air on NBC (Channel 5) at a yet-to-be-established day and time.




Call Me Kat (Fox)

The Undoing is Coming to HBO

Nicole Kidman will join forces with Emmy, Oscar and Golden Globe-winning director Susanne Bier and reunite with Emmy-winning *Big Little Lies* creator David E. Kelley for The Undoing, a limited series based on the book *You Should Have Known* by Jean Hanff Korelitz.

Joining Kidman are Hugh Grant and Donald Sutherland. The story focuses on a successful therapist, Grace Fraser (Kidman), along with her husband, Jonathan (Grant), and their young son who attends an elite private school in New York City. A chasm opens in her seemingly perfect life: a violent death, a missing spouse and, in the place of a man Grace thought she knew, only a chain of terrible revelations. Left behind in the wake of a spreading and very public disaster, and horrified by the ways in which she has failed to heed her own advice, Grace must dismantle one life and create another for her child and herself.
