

An ongoing challenge the salon has faced is a shortage of stylists. "We've been on the hunt for another stylist or two for most of

the seven years we've been open. People have come and gone, but my partner in crime, Chelsea, has been here from the start. I really appreciate her dedication and support," Gurdak said.

She continued, "This job can be pretty demanding, both physically and emotionally. I think the popularity of the career in general has gone down. It takes a real passion to master the craft and actually enjoy it without getting burned out. I love my job and the community connections we've made. I want to find another stylist who feels the same, but I'm starting to think it may be close to impossible. I keep encouraging guests and friends to pursue this career. I wonder if we lost a lot of the workforce to a combination of retirement (if it was available) and career burnout. Hinesburg Hair Studio is not alone in being short staffed, and I'm sad to see so many of our local businesses shutting down. I try to buy local whenever possible!"


